Transpeak	Buxton - Ashford-in-the-Water - Bakewell - Rowsley - Matlock - Matlock Bath - Belper - Derby. Approximately hourly from 7am to 7pm. Takes in The Heights of Abraham, Peak Rail, Peak Shopping Village, Haddon Hall and Poole's Cavern.
Stagecoach 65-66	Buxton to Sheffield via Tideswell and Grindleford. Approximately 2 hourly from 7am to 5pm Monday to Sunday.
441/442 High Peak	Buxton to Ashbourne via Hartington and Tissington. Approximately hourly Monday to Saturday from 7am to 5.30 pm

If you're staying at The Palace Hotel in Buxton and looking for some day trip ideas, you have plenty of options to explore the picturesque Peak District and surrounding areas by bus.

These are a few of our favourite places to visit during your stay –

Heights of Abraham

Take a cable car flight to the Heights of Abraham 60-acre hilltop park, with cavern tours, exhibitions, adventure play and much more.

Matlock Bath is served by regular services from Buxton with Transpeak.

Haddon Hall

Take a step back in time and experience the wonder of Medieval and Elizabethan architecture as you explore Haddon Hall, one of the country's most elegant and historically important stately homes.

Buses stop at the car park entrance with regular services from Buxton onboard the Transpeak.





VISIT PEAK DISTRICT & DERBYSHIRE

Peak Shopping Village

Laid back shopping in the heart of the Peak District. A delightful outdoor shopping centre with a wide range of shops and restaurants. Try Chatsworth Kitchen for a seasonal dish sourced locally from the Derbyshire Dales.

Served by regular bus services from Buxton with Transpeak the bus stops just outside Rowsley.

Walks from Matlock: High Tor, Giddy Edge and Lovers walk

A linear walk with superb cliff-top views, from Giddy Edge Matlock to Matlock Bath via High Tor. You start this walk from the centre of Matlock and end at the Grand Pavilion in Matlock Bath.

Served by regular bus services from Buxton with Transpeak.

Take a scenic bus journey through the Peak District with service 65

This Stagecoach service provides a connection from Buxton to Millers Dale, Tideswell, Eyam, and Grindleford.

Step back in time in the atmospheric setting of Eyam, known to visitors and residents alike as the 'Plague Village'. You can find out more at Eyam Museum, open from March to November.

Take the Stagecoach 65/66 service for a walking trip to Padley Gorge or Longshaw Estate or climbing at Burbage or Horseshoe Quarry.

Tissington Trail

The Tissington Trail runs for 13 miles from Ashbourne to Parsley Hay. You can walk, cycle or ride a horse on the trails all year round.

Pick up the trail in the pretty villages of Tissington or Hartington from the High Peak 441/442 service.
